PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED. Students not registered will be sent to the Front Office. Register online at www.agourahillsrec.org or in person at the Agoura Hills Recreation and Event Center – 29900 Ladyface Court. Refunds, credits or transfers are only given to students who withdraw or transfer prior to the second meeting of each class. Discounts will not be given for late registrations. The enrichment program is privately run and is not affiliated with Willow Elementary school and/or Las Virgenes Unified School District.

After School:

- Journeys/Kindergarten – 1st Grade: Students will be escorted to their Enrichment class.
- 2nd – 5th Grade: Student will walk over to the Enrichment class.
- Wednesday: Journeys/Kindergarten and 1st Grade students will be escorted to their class/lunch tables. Grades 2nd – 5th will walk themselves to the lunch tables. Supervised lunch is from 12:10-12:45pm.

Pick-Up Procedures:

Journeys and Kindergarten students will need to be picked up in person at the Kinder yard. Grades 1st – 5th can either be picked up at the front of the school or students can sign themselves out if indicated on the parent authorization pick-up form. YMCA students will be escorted to the YMCA facility.

Late Pick-up Policy: The Department of Community Services personnel are unavailable to supervise children after the enrichment class. If a child is picked up late from a program a \$10.00 late pick-up fee will be assessed for every 30 minutes of employee overtime. This charge must be paid prior to the next class meeting. Two documented late pick-up notices of 15 minutes each will be considered a 30-minute violation and a fine will be imposed. If a child is picked up late two or more times they may be dropped from the class without a refund.

Important: Students must be picked up immediately after their enrichment class. There is NO supervision for enrichment students after classes, unless attending the YMCA.
